General Seasonal Reminders



- One of the busiest travel days of the year- if possible, stay local
- The weather forecast is not exactly rosy for end of the week get your winter gear out
- Remember, it is deer season. Stay alert if driving at night.
- Slow down in freezing rain, sleet, snow, or when temps fall below 32. Bridge decks will ice up early.
- Let your vehicle warm up for a few mins. Run defroster, fan to circulate air.
- Check your tires, balance pressures. Check tread, you will need the grip in snow.



Seasonal Reminders



- Before you hang the Holiday Lights, check cords for defects. Electrical fires are common around Holidays
- Use <u>correct ladder</u> or other hardware for installing decorations.
- Avoid climbing on the roof without safety precautions. Get assistance when needed.
- Keep a bag or bucket of sand handy for icy spots on walkways. Provide a scoop for dispersal. Keep it dry or it will cake & freeze. Avoid rock salt when possible, it makes a huge mess.
- Clean the snow/ice off walkways early and often.
